In June 2007, the agency screened in and investigated an allegation of maltreatment to the older child. The allegation was unsubstantiated and the child was determined safe. The mother was provided with information about community resources, and the case was closed.

Summary of any investigation conducted under ch. 48 or ch. 938 and any services provided to the family since the date of the incident:

The agency substantiated physical abuse and neglect to the child. Due to the severity of the injuries and the mother's lack of protective capacities, both the injured child and his sibling were taken into Temporary Physical Custody and placed with relatives. The mother's visits with the child are supervised. The mother has been referred to needed services. The child's health continues to be monitored, and he has been referred to services. All of the involved family members are receiving support and services through from the agency. The case is open for Ongoing Services case management.

* Summary of actions taken by agency in response to the incident:

The agency screened in and investigated the report of serious injuries to the child. Physical abuse by the boyfriend and neglect by the mother were substantiated. Both children were determined unsafe in their mother's care. A protective plan was implemented, and the agency took custody of both children. The injured child was first placed in foster care and then placed with his father and older sibling. The mother's visits with the children are supervised. The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professional during the initial assessment. The agency has referred family members to needed services. The case is open for Ongoing Services.

*Summary of policy or practice changes to address identified issues:

The initial assessment is not in full compliance with the CPS Access and Initial Assessment Standards. The DSP is working with the agency on the identified issues.
