Maltreatment was unsubstantiated, and the children were determined safe. The family was already connected to community services, and the case was closed. On 4/2/09 Buffalo County DHHS screened out a child welfare Services Report. On 7/19/05, Buffalo County DHHS screened out a CPS Report.
