The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical personnel to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the infant by the father. Medical professionals determined the infant sustained head injuries and diagnosed the infant with Abusive Head Trauma. The agency determined the infant safe and the infant returned home with the mother upon release from the hospital as the father remained incarcerated. The family was referred to community services and the agency closed the case
