The agency collaborated with law enforcement and medical professionals to complete the assessment. The Initial Assessment completed by the agency found a preponderance of the evidence to substantiate maltreatment of physical abuse to the 12-year-old child and 8-year-old child by the grandfather. The Medical Examiner's Office determined the injuries and death to be non-accidental in nature. The 8-year-old child and his siblings were deemed safe, and they remained with their grandmother. The agency closed the case upon completion of the Initial Assessment, and no service referrals were made.
