On April 11, 2011, the mother called law enforcement, reporting that her child was not breathing and asking what she should do. The child was taken to the hospital and later transferred to the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. The child is reported to have widespread hemorrhages of different ages on the brain and does not have any brain activity. The doctor believes the multiple injuries are traumatic brain injuries.
