








Long Term Goal-WI B-5 Strategic Plan

Key Strategic Elements – Overview

North Star



Desired future state that informs the "why" behind all work.

Population Results

Conditions of well-being for entire populations—children, adults, families, or communities that are stated in plain language. Results are supported by measurable indicators.

Strategies

Cross-cutting strategies that guide the work of the system for the next five years.
Strategies are accompanied by key milestones and activities.

Core Values

Inform how the system does its work and how organizations and stakeholders interact with one another. They are the core elements that guide how work is approached.



Key Strategic Elements – Project Example

North Star



Healthy babies, strong families, and foundations for lifelong success.

Population Results

- All babies are born healthy
- All children live in a safe and nurturing environment
- All children are kindergarten ready
- All children demonstrate third grade achievement

Strategies

- Strengthen and sustain the Early Success Coalition infrastructure to serve as Shelby County's Young Child Wellness Council.
- Strengthen comprehensive early childhood system across Shelby County to better foster cognitive, physical and social-emotional development of young children.
- Demonstrate an effective comprehensive neighborhood young child

Core Values

ESC services for children and families in Shelby County will strive to promote the five protective factors defined by the *Strengthening Families* framework: Parent resilience, Knowledge of parenting and child development, Social connections, Concrete support in times of need Children's social emotional development
