**Subject:** Removal of C9 Verification Code from Cares Worker Web (CWW)

Good Morning,

Effective January 16, 2023, the C9 verification code that was created to allow for the use of best available information in lieu of verification during the COVID-19 public health emergency will be removed from Cares Worker Web (CWW). Please see OMs 20-07 and 21-21 for more information on the C9 code.

CWW will display the message below when a page in a driver flow includes the C9 code or when a worker makes an update to a page that includes the C9 code.

The following event has occurred: Q.403: Please update verification fields that have 'C9 - COVID-19' to another value.

When replacing the C9 code, workers should follow current verification policy as outlined in section 4.1 of the W-2 policy manual and request verification for any items currently verified using the C9 code.

## NOTE:

For FEPs, the Social Security Application Date verification field on the permanent Demographics page cannot be changed once it is saved. The C9 code does not have to be removed and replaced since SSN application date is a one time verification.
